

#### PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

PhD students will enrol in the 'Research Methods for Hospitality & Tourism' subject, which advances students' understanding in and application of developing, conducting, and disseminating their own research. The subject is not graded but must be successfully completed.

PhD candidates will be empowered to complete an in-depth study on a particular research topic in the form of a thesis, substantiated by a series of academic milestones including a proposal defense and a viva voce. where the research outcomes ultimately contribute to the knowledge base of hospitality and tourism and its scholarly and professional communities.

Additional required academic activities are regular consultations with the supervisory team, regular progress reports, the completion of a research ethics workshop and training programme, a conference presentation, and the submission of a manuscript to an academic journal.

- 1. Full-time and part-time International and Malaysia students.
- 2. Applicant must not be a recipient of any other scholarships.
- 3. Must meet either one of the below criteria:
  - al Criteria 1
    - Meet the entry requirements of the programme.
    - Possess evidence of a minimum 3 years working experience within the hospitality and tourism industry or other related service sector industries.
  - bl Criteria 2
  - Possess a recognised pre-university certification (STPM, diploma, matriculation, or equivalent) and have successfully attained the APEL T-7 recognition as awarded by the Malaysian Qualification Agency.
  - Possess evidence of a minimum of 5 years working experience within the hospitality and tourism industry or other related service sector industries.

#### REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Certified true copies of academic transcripts.
- Letter of Intent for applying for the programme.

#### 2. TAUGHT POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SUNWAY UNIVERSITY TAUGHT MASTERS SCHOLARSHIP**

- a) Validity period of the Bachelor degree academic result to apply is 2 years AND with a CGPA of 3.50 and above.
- b) Value of the scholarship is 50% off the total tuition fee.
- c) Application is applicable to ALL Bachelor degree graduates within Sunway Education Group as well as other higher education institutions.
- d) Applicants are only entitled to ONE scholarship offered by Sunway University at any one time, whichever amount is higher. It is not to be combined with any other scholarship or bursary.
- e) Applicants are required to submit their application online via https://sunway.edu.my/scholarship-app/

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ALUMNI BURSARY**

- a) NO validity period of Bachelor degree academic results to apply for Alumni Bursary.
- b) Value of the Alumni Bursary is 30% off the total tuition fee.
- c) Application is ONLY applicable to Sunway College (VUBB/ACCA/ICAEW) and Sunway University Bachelor degree graduates.
- d) Applicants are only entitled to ONE bursary offered by Sunway University at any one time, whichever amount is higher. It is not to be combined with any other scholarship or bursary.

#### 3. PhD STUDENTSHIP

- 100% tuition fee waiver and coverage of all other fees such as registration and visa-related fees
- Monthly stipend of RM3,000 for 3 years
- Opportunity to join the Asia Pacific Centre for Hospitality Research (APCHR) of the School of Hospitality and Service Management

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Master degree in Hospitality / Tourism or a related field
- Master degree with CGPA of 3.50 and above (or equivalent)
- Published one Scopus-indexed or equivalent output (please include the link to your Scopus profile in your CV, if available)

#### REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Master degree certificate and official academic transcripts
- Proof of English proficiency
- Detailed and updated Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Research statement / proposal (2,000 words, excluding references)

Please note that ALL documents need to be complete prior to submission. Supplementary documents may be requested for further review. All candidates are required to go through a selection process. Only a limited number of students will be shortlisted.

#### 4. POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES BY RESEARCH

#### Eligibility Criteria for Bursary or Scholarship

Bursary or Scholarship are open to all **full-time postgraduate** students enrolled for programmes by research. Eligibility criteria are given in the table below. Additionally, applicants must meet all necessary entry requirements for their chosen programme of study and be in receipt of an unconditional offer from the University.

Awards made to students under this scheme shall take effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of enrolment. They shall, subject to satisfactory performance and successful progression, last for the normal duration of the programme. The University reserves the right to withdraw the award at any time should the student's behaviour or performance be unsatisfactory, or the student withdraws or is withdrawn from the programme of study.

The student must have successfully completed their proposal defense, have received ethics approval and be able to demonstrate that data collection has commenced by the end of year 1 to continue the scholarship funding for year 2.
