LAUNCHING OF AED POSTGRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN HIGHER EDUCATION PRACTICE

AED is proud to announce that we will be offering our Postgraduate Certificate in Higher Education Practice programme (PgCert in HEP) beginning August 2022. In addition to MQA's provisional accreditation, the programme is also accredited by Advance HE, UK. This means that successful graduates will also be awarded Advance HE Fellowship, an international recognition of high quality teaching and learning, thus making the programme the first of its kind in Malaysia.

The Pg Cert in HE Practice is suitable for Sunway academics who seek to improve their understanding of and skills in teaching and learning in higher education. The programme will be taught and supported by AED and Sunway academics who have obtained Senior Fellowship or Fellowship from Higher Education Academy (HEA, UK).

UPDATE ON 2ND COURSE ON BLOCK TEACHING

In a continuous effort to support the university's transition to block teaching, AED launched the 2nd course on block teaching on OpenLearning-Redesigning Teaching, Learning and Assessment.

Since its launch, six departments/ centres have completed the course with more expected to join the course in the second half of the year. However, in response to the University's decision to defer the block mode implementation, AED has also put a pause to this initiative until further notice.

Certificates of completion have been issued to colleagues who have completed this course. It still counts towards completion of the required professional development for the year.
