Professor Anthony Saich is a Daewoo Professor of International Affairs at Harvard University, teaching courses on comparative political institutions, democratic governance and transitional economies with a focus on China. He is also a guest professor at the School of Public Policy and Management at Tsinghua University, China.

Professor Saich advises a wide range of government, private and non-profit organisations on work in China and elsewhere in Asia. He is a trustee member of the National Committee on US - China Relations and the China Medical Board. He is also the US States Secretary–General of the China United Strategic Philanthropy.

In this lecture, Professor Saich will evaluate the policy directions since Xi Jinping took over the leadership of the Chinese Communist Party. It looks at his political and economic objectives and gauges the extent to which they might be achieved. The talk concludes by outlining some possible scenarios for China's future development and their consequences.
